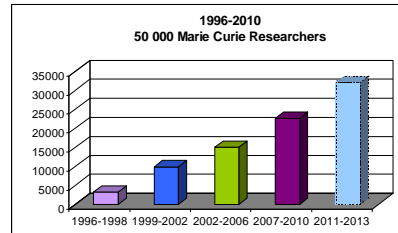

## What are the Marie Curie Actions?



Pierre and Marie Curie honeymoon, 1895



- Significant EC fellowships programmes since 1990 (FP3) for researchers' mobility
- Marie Curie label since 1996 (**50000** fellows to date)
- Actions aimed at structuring training, mobility and career development for researchers.
- Implemented through People Programme (FP7 2007-2013)

### Overall scope

- Human resource development in R&D in Europe
  - Numerous, well-trained, motivated researchers
- Attract students to research careers
- Attract researchers to Europe
- Skills and sustainable career development



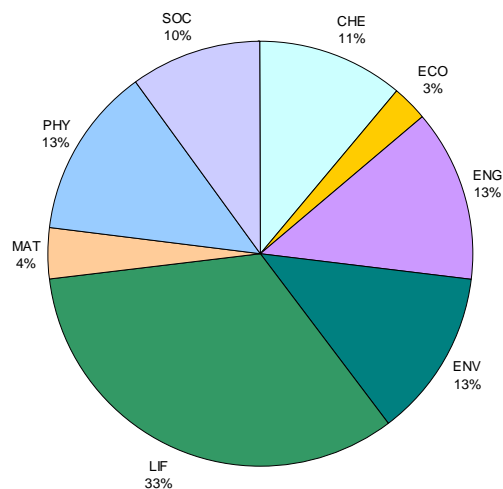
## The Marie Curie Actions

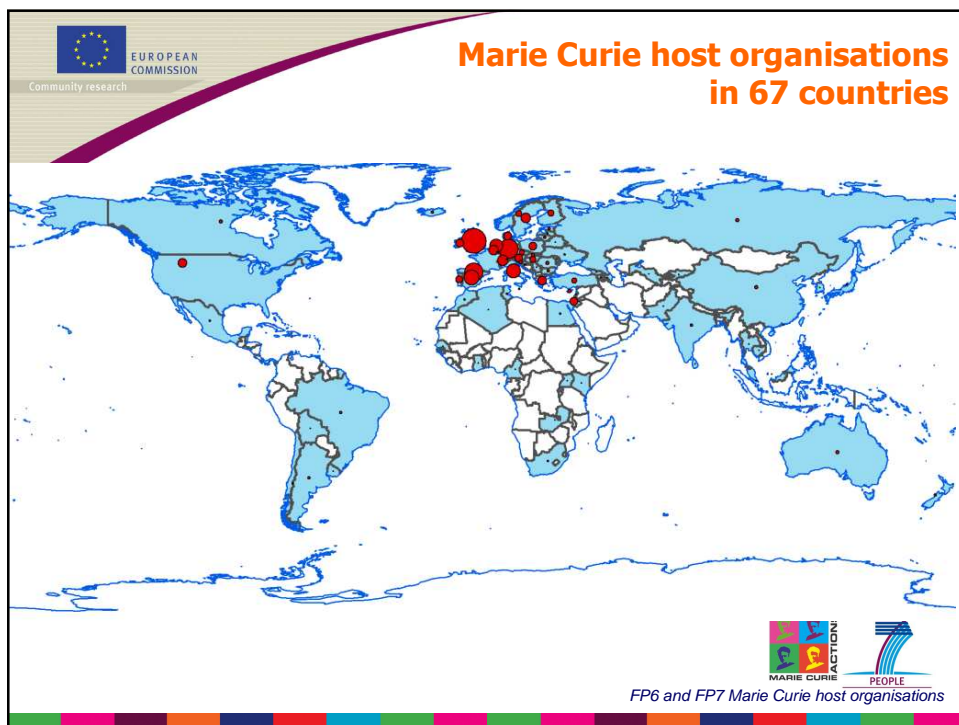
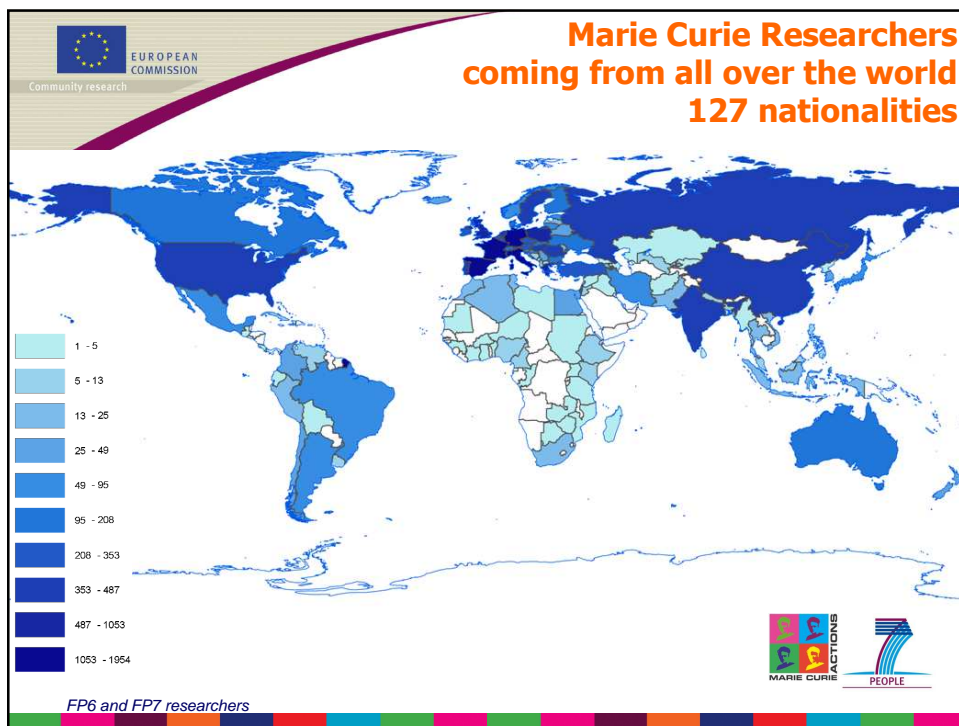
- Addressed to researchers of any nationality at all stages of their careers
- Open to all domains of research (bottom-up)
- Mobility (international, intersectoral, interdisciplinary)
- Selection criteria: S&T quality, Quality of participants, Implementation and Impact
- Budget covers generally salary, mobility and research budget for the researcher
- Application through competitive calls for proposals...
- ... leading to excellence

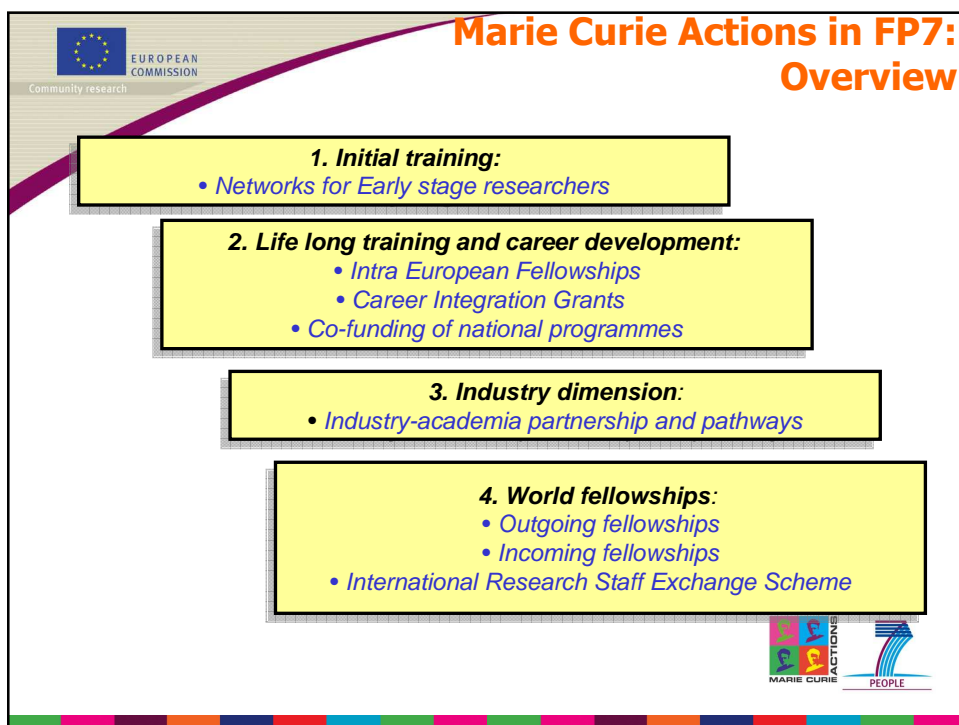
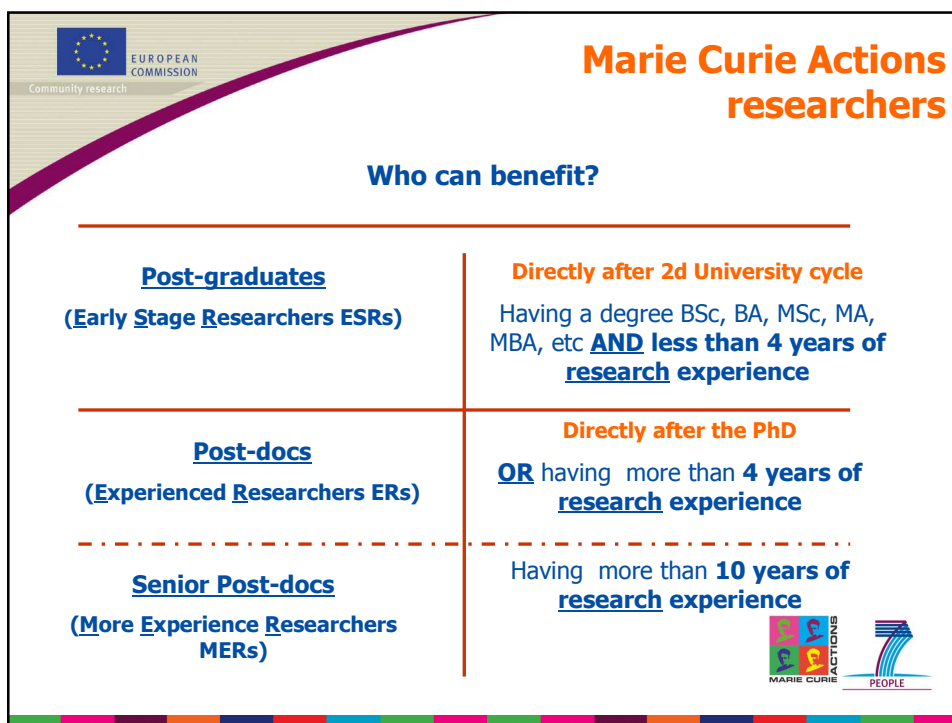


## The bottom up approach

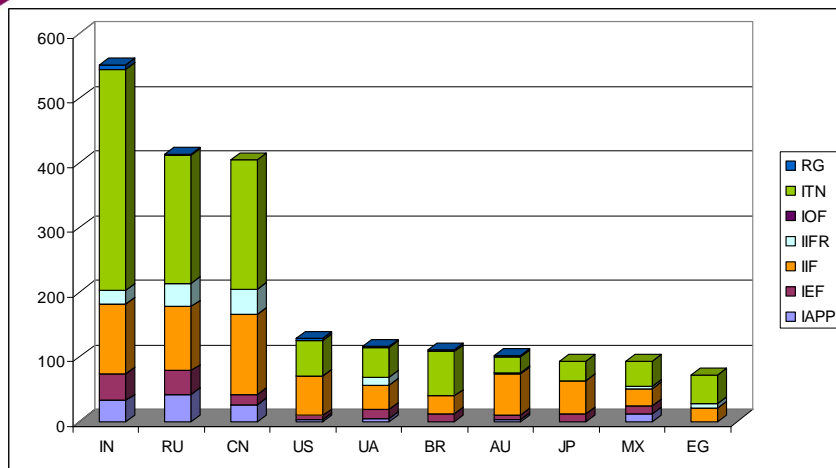
- Bottom-up programme: open to all research fields



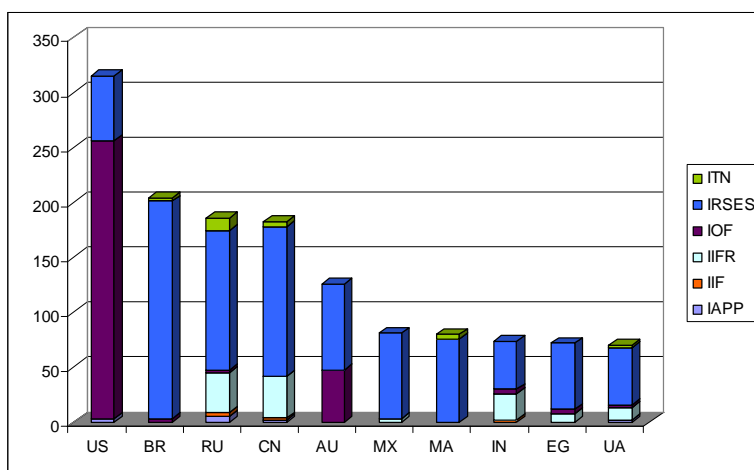




## Funded researchers in the FP7 Marie Curie actions top 10 third countries

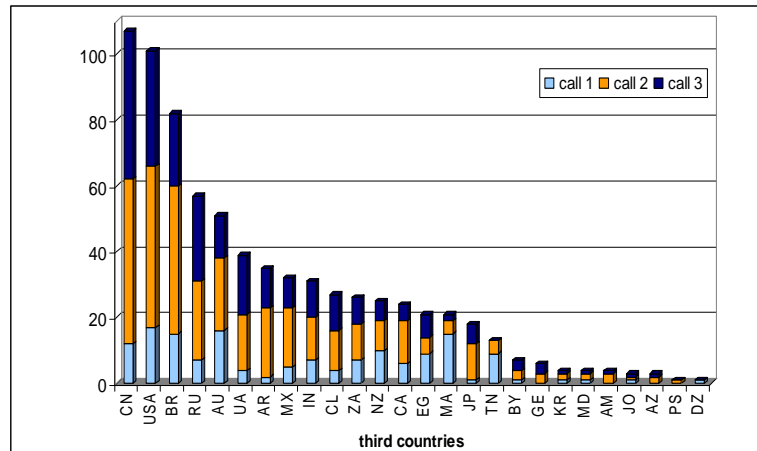


## Funded institutions in the FP7 Marie Curie actions top 10 third countries

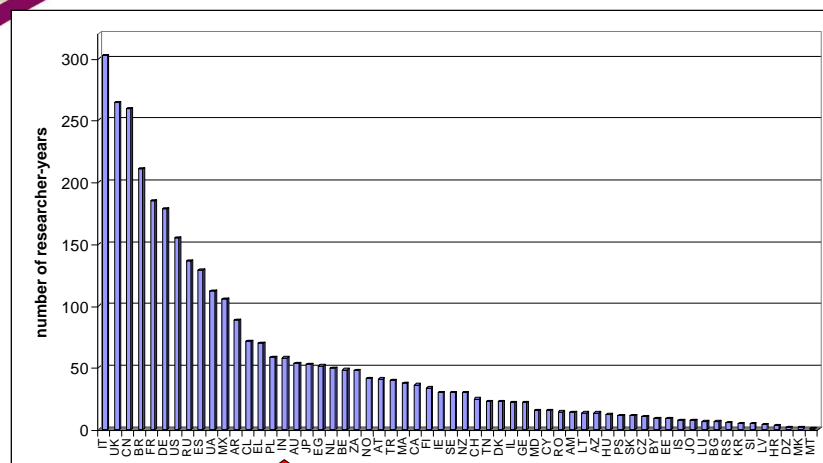


## Achievements so far in IRSES
